Everyone benefits by having Maximum hunting opportunity and hunter retention because it bolsters the Missouri economy. The economic impact is many, many times more than that of hunting license sold. For example, deer hunting alone in Wisconsin contributes more than \$1 billion in economic impact annually. Texas deer hunters contribute at least three times that much. Don't take my word for it, though, here are the straight-up facts from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service: The top 10 states in the number of hunters in 2004 – Missouri came in 8th with 539,062. We are talking about all hunters here, and that includes anyone who goes out for deer, turkey, rabbit, squirrel, duck, pheasant, and so on. But the terrible policies from the Missouri Department of Conservation over the last several years Missouri no longer even comes in the top ten of hunters in 2021 per U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service. So, they are caused less hunting opportunity and less hunter retention – Under a horrible policy under the leadership of the MDC. Top 10 States for Total Hunting Fee Revenue, 2021 – Missouri does not even make it in the top 10 for residents hunting fees. Top 10 States for Nonresident Hunting Fee Revenue, 2021 – Missouri has FALLEN to 10TH place. Cause and effect of terrible MDC policy! If you don't think MDC policies matter – Ignoring the problem with wild turkey is one example – With Fur prices at the lowest in history for years now the carrying capacity of predators have reached an all time high. I have sent letters since 2012 to the commission with an answer of "We won't extend season for landowners because of prime fur" – Prime fur does not matter until it becomes worthless. Missouri Sets TWO season records in 2021. 2021 is Missouri Worst Fall Turkey Season in history total 1,836! – This after the 2021 Spring Missouri Wild Turkey Season which now holds the record of the worst season in 24-year history of a three-week season in Missouri. They keep saying number of hens killed do not matter to the population, DEAD HENS DON'T LAY EGGS – If they cannot replace themselves in the short term or long-term RIGHT NOW per MDC 5-year search – dead hen definably will not. Even though Wild Turkey research outside of Missouri show otherwise! FAMED Tennessee biologist Jack Murray – "If you don't have hens, you won't have any gobblers and if you don't have gobblers, you don't have HUNTERS." 2007 – 161,000 wild turkey permits sold vs 2021 – 124,000 wild turkey permits sold. 2015 – Youth Turkey Season Total Harvest – 4,441 – Highest vs 2021 – Youth Turkey Season Total – 2,771 So why would you restrict landowners even more like the MDC did? MDC is filled with bureaucratic biologist and bureaucratic leadership.

The Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) is not a Legislative Body and should not be in the business of registering private property to issue landowner deer & turkey hunting permits, which provided access by a 3rd Party (permit vendors). The three rights are so bound together as to be essentially one right. To give a person their life but deny them their liberty, is to take from them all that make life with living. To give them liberty but take from them the property which is the fruit and badge of liberty, is to still leave them a

slave. (Principle of Expedient? Annual Address to the New York State Bar Association, 21 January 1921, page 18.)The government cannot take from any person any part of their property (including hunting rights) without their own consent. For the preservation of property being the end of government, and that for which men enter into society, it necessarily supposes and requires that the people should have property, without which they must be supposed to lose that property by entering into society, which was the end for which they entered into it. - John LockeWhat the MDC (a government agency) has done is encroach on Private Personal Property Rights and this Bill seeks to end that encroachment!I ask that our representatives understand that Life and Liberty are secure only so long as the right of private property is secure and to protect private property from any and all encroachments on private property by the government and its agencies!

On behalf of the Conservation Federation of Missouri, we would like to go on record opposing HB 1694. We are comprised of nearly 100 conservation and outdoor organizations, representing over 80,000 Missouri citizens and members. Our organization was founded in 1935 based on the premise of keeping conservation decisions based on science and not by political pressure. Wildlife belongs to the citizens of this state, not the landowner. The justification for free deer and turkey permits is intended to recognize the value of private land and habitat to the public resource. Five acres is just too small for that justification for big game, such as deer and turkey. The decision to shift from 5 to 20 acres was made with a great deal of public input and very little opposition. The Conservation Commission did amend their proposal, leaving free landowner trapping, fishing, and small game hunting at the 5-acre minimum. Only deer/turkey tags are subjected to the 20-acre minimum. When we learned about the people that landowners were abusing the system, then it made even more sense to institute this change. Abuse of the free tag system where people were taking advantage of this is a direct theft of a public resource. Landowners are not required to use the registry in order to hunt on their own land. If they choose, they buy tags like any other hunter. We have not had members come forward saying they are opposed to the landowner registry. My Name is Zach Morris and I am from Columbia. I am a biologist for an environmental services company and an avid hunter and angler. I would like to testify in opposition to this bill. I am opposed to both aspects of this bill. In regard to the first portion, which prevents the Conservation Department from maintaining a landowner registry, this would lead to a lot of fraud. I do think certain landowners should be able to get free hunting permits, but I also think you should be able to prove that you own the land in order to get the permits. If there is no registry, what would stop someone from lying on his or her permit application and cheating the system? I register my car, my house, and my boat because the law requires it and I see no efforts to repeal these requirements. I don't see a need to eliminate the landowner registration required by the Conservation Department, and I think this would lead to people cheating the system and stealing resources from ethical hunters like me. I am also opposed to the language regarding the amount of land required to obtain free landowner permits. I understand the Conservation Department recently raised this requirement from five acres to 20 acres. I think the Conservation Department know the best way to manage their permit requirements and the impacts thereof to wildlife populations. Further, I don't think that five acres is enough land to justify a free permit. There is very little you can do to manage for game species on such a small parcel. Certainly, many species benefit from habitat improvements on small acreages, but no game animal in Missouri can survive on only five acres. They need multiple habitat types that exist across the landscape, which is why I don't think landowners with such small acreages should receive free permits. The home range of something like a whitetail deer is much larger than 20 acres, but if the Conservation Department thinks this is a fair acreage requirement for free permits, then I support keeping the requirements where they are.
