

HB 657 -- One-Time Comparative Audits of State Agencies

Sponsor: Allen

This bill requires the State Auditor to conduct a one-time comparative audit of at least five but no more than 10 of the largest state agencies as determined by total appropriations for Fiscal Year 2011 by August 28, 2013. Upon completion of the audit, the State Auditor must submit a report of the findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and all statewide elected officials, the Office of Administration, and all state departments containing the optimal fiscal practices to be promoted across all state agencies and other efficiency or cost-saving measures that could reduce government spending.
