HB 731 -- FEDERAL REPORTING OF ILLEGAL ALIENS ON THE SEXUAL OFFENDER REGISTRY

SPONSOR: Parkinson

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass" by the Committee on International Trade and Job Creation by a vote of 13 to 0.

This bill adds citizenship to the information that must be included on a sexual offender registration form and requires the State Highway Patrol to report to the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement or other appropriate federal agency certain information regarding any person on the sexual offender registry who is not a citizen of the United States and to request a determination as to whether the person is subject to deportation as a criminal illegal alien.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that illegal aliens who have committed sexual offenses in Missouri should be deported at the earliest possible time.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Parkinson.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
