HB 908 -- Economic Development in the Kansas City Metropolitan Area

Beginning July 1, 2013, this bill requires that for every \$1 spent by the State of Kansas for promoting economic development in the Kansas counties that are part of the Kansas City metropolitan area, the State of Missouri must spend \$1.50 for promoting economic development in the Missouri counties that are part of the Kansas City metropolitan area. "Kansas City metropolitan area" means the multi-county metropolitan area straddling the border between Missouri and Kansas consisting of the Missouri counties of Cass, Clay, Jackson, and Platte and the Kansas counties of Johnson, Leavenworth, and Wyandotte.
