HB 919 -- Community Improvement Districts

Sponsor: Schupp

This bill specifies that for the purpose of the election of directors of a community improvement district (CID) board a qualified voter includes a registered voter or owner of real property within the district on which taxes are assessed or levied as of the thirtieth day prior to the election if the owner is:

- (1) At least 18 years of age on the date of the election;
- (2) Not otherwise disqualified to vote;
- (3) Allowed only one vote regardless of the number of parcels owned; and
- (4) Allowed only one vote regardless of whether the owner is also a registered voter in the CID.

The bill also specifies that the legally authorized representative of an entity owning real property in the district may vote in any district election if otherwise qualified to vote under the CID laws.
