HB 941 -- Identity Theft

Sponsor: Johnson

This bill increases the penalty for identity theft or attempted identity theft which does not result in the theft or appropriation of credit, money, goods, services, or other property from a class B misdemeanor to a class D felony and increases the penalty for identity theft which results in the theft or appropriation of credit, money, goods, services, or other property not exceeding \$500 in value from a class A misdemeanor to a class D felony.

The penalty for anyone who has previously pled guilty to or been found guilty of one of these crimes is increased from a class D felony to a class C felony.
