

HB 1004 -- Repeal of Obsolete Education Provisions

Sponsor: Lampe

This bill repeals the following obsolete provisions regarding education:

- (1) The one-year nonrenewable scholarship for qualified students pursuing a teacher education degree;
- (2) The Missouri Award of Recognition for student athletes;
- (3) The Missouri Senior Cadets Program;
- (4) The four-year competitive grant program for the establishment or expansion of student suicide prevention programs;
- (5) The one-year renewable minority scholarships for qualified Missouri minority students to enter teaching;
- (6) The appointment of state and area advisory committees to make recommendations to the various state schools for severely handicapped children;
- (7) The New Schools Pilot Project;
- (8) The Elementary and Secondary School District Enrollment Option Act;
- (9) The Missouri Advisory Council of Certification for Educators;
- (10) The Administrator Assessment Center;
- (11) The Missouri Teacher Corps Program;
- (12) The designation of school holidays including Thanksgiving Day, December 25, the third Monday in February, and July 4;
- (13) The State Advisory Committee for Vocational Education; and
- (14) State aid to sheltered workshops and the Sheltered Workshop Per Diem Revolving Fund.
