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1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1275, Page 1, Section 67.005, Line 18  
2 by inserting after said line the following:

3 "67.548. 1. In any first or second class county not having  
4 a charter form of government, which contains all or any part of a  
5 city with a population of greater than four hundred thousand  
6 inhabitants, in which the voters have approved a sales tax as  
7 provided by section 67.547, the county commission may:

8 (1) Reduce or eliminate the county general fund levy, the  
9 special road and bridge levy, or the park levy; [and]

10 (2) Grant county [sales tax] revenues to cities, towns and  
11 villages and to special road districts organized pursuant to  
12 chapter 233;

13 (3) Enter into agreements with cities, towns, villages, and  
14 special road districts organized under chapter 233 for the  
15 purpose of working cooperatively on the roads and bridges located  
16 within the county, including the distribution of funds to such  
17 entities in addition to those funds described in subsection 2 of  
18 this section.

19 2. [If the county commission reduces a special road and  
20 bridge tax levy pursuant to this section which results in a  
21 reduction of revenue available to a city, town or village or to a  
22 special road district organized pursuant to chapter 233, the  
23 commission shall in that year in which the reduction of revenue  
24 occurs set aside and place to the credit of each such entity  
25 sales tax revenues in an amount at least equal to that which each  
26 such entity would have otherwise been entitled from the special  
27 road and bridge tax levy, had it not been for such reduction. In  
28 subsequent years, each such entity shall receive from the county  
29 an amount of sales tax revenue equal to the amount of special  
30 road and bridge tax revenue that each such entity would have  
31 received in that year, but for the reduction in the special road

1 and bridge tax. The county shall transfer such sales tax revenue  
2 to each such entity in twelve equal monthly installments during  
3 each year in which such entity is entitled to receive such sales  
4 tax revenue] In any county in which the voters have approved a  
5 sales tax as provided by section 67.547, each city, town,  
6 village, and special road district organized under chapter 233  
7 shall continue to receive its share of the county's special road  
8 and bridge levy, if any, that is annually considered by the  
9 county commission. In the event that the annual special road and  
10 bridge levy is not set at a level of at least fourteen cents on  
11 each one hundred dollars assessed valuation, the county  
12 commission shall allocate additional funds from any available  
13 county source to the cities, towns, villages, and special road  
14 districts located within the county in an amount that will, when  
15 combined with the revenues received from the special road and  
16 bridge levy, distribute funds to such entities in an amount that  
17 is at least equal to the funding level of fourteen cents on each  
18 one hundred dollars assessed valuation. Additionally, any city,  
19 town, or village which contains at least fifty percent of a  
20 special road district organized under chapter 233 shall be  
21 entitled to receive the road district's portion of any funds not  
22 paid through the special road and bridge levy. Any funds paid  
23 under this subsection shall be paid as if the funds were paid  
24 under the county's special road and bridge levy."; and

25 238.415. 1. A road and bridge revitalization district may  
26 be established in the portion of a home rule city with more than  
27 four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one  
28 county that is located in a county of the first classification  
29 with more than two hundred thousand but fewer than two hundred  
30 sixty thousand inhabitants, after voter approval pursuant to this  
31 section. A road and bridge revitalization district shall exist  
32 to revitalize, repair, replace, and construct new roads, bridges,  
33 and related public infrastructure, including storm water control  
34 systems. The boundaries of the district may be of any dimensions  
35 within the portion of the city within such county that may be  
36 deemed necessary or advisable. The governing body of the  
37 municipality may establish such district by ordinance and  
38 authorize the imposition of a tax to support the district. The  
39 ordinance shall require the ad valorem tax to be submitted to the  
40 voters for reauthorization and shall specify the period of time

1 before such reauthorization shall be required, which time period  
2 shall not be more than ten years. No such ordinance shall become  
3 effective unless the governing body of the municipality submits  
4 to the voters residing within the district at a state general,  
5 primary, or special election a proposal to authorize the creation  
6 of the district and the imposition of the tax. The municipality  
7 shall include in the ballot a provision for a tax to support the  
8 district in an amount not to exceed ten cents per one hundred  
9 dollars assessed valuation of all taxable property within the  
10 district pursuant to available statutory authority.

11 2. The ballot for the proposition in the district shall be  
12 in substantially the following form:

13 Shall there be established a Road and Bridge Revitalization  
14 District with a tax rate of not more than .....(insert amount)  
15 cents per hundred dollars assessed valuation of all taxable  
16 property within the district for ..... years, unless  
17 reauthorized by the voters?

20 3. In the event that a majority of the voters voting on  
21 such proposition in the proposed district at such election cast  
22 votes for the proposition, then the district shall be established  
23 and the tax rate shall be in full force and effect as of the  
24 first day of the year following the year of the election. The  
25 results of the election shall be certified by the election  
26 officials of the city not less than thirty days after the day of  
27 election. In the event the proposition fails to receive a  
28 majority of the votes in the proposed district, then such  
29 proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held within  
30 one year of the date of the election the proposition was  
31 rejected."; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
34 accordingly.
