1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1060, Page 3,
2 Section 115.124, Line 3, by inserting after the word
3 "inhabitants" the following: "or any city, town, or village with
4 three thousand or fewer inhabitants"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 115.124, Line 29,
6 by inserting after all of said line the following:

7 "3. In any city, town, or village with three thousand or
8 fewer inhabitants, candidates may assume offices in nonpartisan
9 elections as provided in subsection 1 of this section upon the
10 approval of the voters of the city, town, or village. The
11 governing body of such city, town, or village may submit to the
12 voters at any election available for the city, town, or village a
13 proposal to adopt the provisions of subsection 1 of this section.
14 If a majority of the votes cast on the question by the qualified
15 voters voting thereon are in favor of the question, then the
16 city, town, or village shall conduct nonpartisan elections as
17 provided in subsection 1 of this section for all nonpartisan
18 elections remaining in the year in which the proposal was adopted
19 and for the twelve calendar years immediately following the
20 approval of the proposal. If a majority of the votes cast on the
21 question by the qualified voters voting thereon are opposed to
22 the question, then the proposal shall not become effective unless
23 and until the question is resubmitted under this section to the
24 qualified voters and such question is approved by a majority of
25 the qualified voters voting on the question. At the end of the
26 twelve-year period in which nonpartisan elections are conducted
27 as provided in subsection 1 of this section, each such city,
28 town, or village shall submit to the voters a proposal to
29 continue conducting nonpartisan elections as provided in
