SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1Offered by Stouffer of _____Amend _____ House Bill No. 1114, Page 1, Section Title, Line 3,

2 by striking all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following: "county government."; and

4 Further amend said bill and page, section A, line 2, by
5 inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "50.622. 1. Any county may amend the annual budget during
7 any fiscal year in which the county receives additional funds,
8 and such amount or source, including but not limited to, federal
9 or state grants or private donations, could not be estimated when
10 the budget was adopted. The county shall follow the same
11 procedures as required in sections 50.525 to 50.745 for adoption
12 of the annual budget to amend its budget during a fiscal year.

13 2. Any county may decrease the annual budget twice during
14 any fiscal year in which the county experiences a verifiable
15 decline in funds of two percent or more, and such amount could
16 not be estimated or anticipated when the budget was adopted,
17 provided that any decrease in appropriations shall not unduly
18 affect any one officeholder. Before any reduction affecting an
19 independently elected officeholder can occur, negotiations shall
20 take place with all officeholders who receive funds from the
21 affected category of funds in an attempt to cover the shortfall.

1 The county shall follow the same procedures as required in
2 sections 50.525 to 50.745 to decrease the annual budget, except
3 that the notice provided for in section 50.600 shall be extended
4 to thirty days for purposes of this subsection. Such notice
5 shall include a published summary of the proposed reductions and
6 an explanation of the shortfall.

7 3. Any decrease in an appropriation authorized under
8 subsection 2 of this section shall not impact any dedicated fund
9 otherwise provided by law.

10 4. County commissioners may reduce budgets of departments
11 under their direct supervision and responsibility at any time
12 without the restrictions imposed by this section.

13 5. Subsections 2, 3, and 4 of this section shall expire on
14 July 1, 2015.

15 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, no
16 charter county shall be restricted from amending its budget
17 pursuant to the terms of its charter."; and

18 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 190.335, line 95,
19 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

20 "Section B. Because of the immediate need of counties to
21 balance their budgets, the repeal and reenactment of section
22 50.622 of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and
24 is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of
25 the constitution, and the repeal and reenactment of section
26 50.622 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its
27 passage and approval."; and

28 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
