ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on school districts.

Officials from the **Parkway, Malta Bend, and Center School Districts** indicated no fiscal impact to their respective districts as a result of this proposed legislation.

Officials from the **Charleston School District** assumed this proposal could have a positive impact on their school finance as state budget projections would be more determined at that time.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
