## AN ACT

To amend chapter 290, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to use of credit scores by employers.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 290, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 290.148, to read as follows:

2 **290.148. It shall be an improper employment practice for an employer to refuse to**  
3 **hire, or to discharge, any individual, or to otherwise disadvantage any individual, with**  
4 **respect to compensation, terms, or conditions of employment based on the individual's**  
5 **credit score or credit history, unless such individual's credit score or credit history is**  
6 **directly, materially, and substantially related to the duties and performance of the**  
**employee or the overall operation of the employer's business.**
