

HB 1044 -- Motor Fuel Price Increase Notifications

This bill requires a motor fuel wholesaler to notify a retailer of any increase in the cost of a gallon of motor fuel of three cents or more at least 24 hours prior to when the increase becomes effective. The wholesaler must provide the retailer at no cost a means of notifying the general public of the increase 24 hours in advance.

The retailer must notify the general public of any increase of three cents or more in the price of a gallon of motor fuel by posting the increase in a location visible to the general public from at least one adjacent public roadway for 24 hours prior to the increase becoming effective.
