

HB 2055 -- School Food Service

Sponsor: Aull

Beginning with school year 2012-2013, this bill requires a food service director or menu planner, whether he or she is an employee of the school or a contracted vendor, hired on or after August 28, 2012, to obtain school food service and nutrition specialist credentials or level 1 Missouri School Nutrition Association certification within two years of his or her appointment. A person appointed prior to August 28, 2012, has until the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year to obtain his or her credentials. The provisions of the bill apply to these employees at public and private schools that receive funding through the federal school lunch program.
