ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** state their Children's Division would not be fiscally impacted as a result of this proposed legislation as its requirements are directed to the Supreme Court and the judge presiding over the adoption proceedings. However, the Children's Division may need to update policy to accommodate the provisions of this bill and put them into practice.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact the courts.
