

HB 92 -- CONCEALED CARRY ENDORSEMENTS

SPONSOR: Gatschenberger

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on General Laws by a vote of 14 to 1.

This bill changes the minimum age at which a person can be issued a concealed carry endorsement from 21 years of age to 19 years of age.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill simply lowers the age in which a person can attempt to obtain an endorsement to carry a concealed firearm.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Gatschenberger; and Missourians for Personal Safety.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
