2 Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 5, Page 7, Section
3 479.372, Line 8, by inserting after all of said line the
4 following:

5 "Section 1. 1. The "Interim Committee on Municipal Court
6 Efficiency" is hereby created to study the efficiency and economy
7 of court operations in individual municipalities as part of a
8 general initiative to improve municipal court function in the
9 state of Missouri. The committee shall identify potential ways
10 to sustain and improve the efficiency of operations and quality
11 of justice provided by the municipal courts.

12 2. The interim committee on municipal court efficiency
13 shall consist of the following members:

14 (1) Two members of the senate, with one member appointed by
15 the president pro tempore of the senate and one member appointed
16 by the minority leader of senate;

17 (2) Two members of the house of representatives, with one
18 member appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives
19 and one member appointed by the minority leader of the house of
20 representatives; and

21 (3) Five members appointed jointly by the president pro
22 tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of
23 representatives, including, but not limited to, persons
24 representing municipal courts, the legal community, cities,
25 towns, and villages.

26 3. All members shall be appointed no later than September
27 15, 2015. The first meeting of the committee shall be conducted
28 no later than October 1, 2015.

1 4. No later than January 5, 2016, the committee shall
2 submit a report to the president pro tempore of the senate, the
3 speaker of the house of representatives, and the appropriate
4 legislative committee of the general assembly regarding the
5 results of the study and any legislative recommendations."; and
