1 AMEND House Bill No. 311, Pages 1-2, Section 160.1000, Lines 3-18, by deleting all of said lines
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall develop a "High
5 Performance Energy Benchmarking Act Award" program to recognize:

6 (1) Missouri public school districts and schools that benchmark using the Energy Star program,
7 co-sponsored by the United States Department of Energy and the United States Environmental
8 Protection Agency. The department of elementary and secondary education shall post the names of
9 these school districts and schools on its website; and

10 (2) Missouri public school districts and schools that achieve Energy Star national recognition. The
11 department of elementary and secondary education shall publicize the names of these school districts
12 and schools.

13 3. The department of elementary and secondary education may further recognize the schools
14 and school districts described under subsection 2 of this section in ways not specifically listed in that
15 subsection.

16 4. Beginning September 1, 2015, the department of elementary and secondary education shall
17 annually notify all Missouri public school districts and school boards of the high performance energy
18 benchmarking act award established under subsection 2 of this section. Each participating school
19 district and school shall use the free online portfolio manager provided by Energy Star to generate an
20 efficiency benchmark rating. Each participating district shall maintain a database of results for each
21 school building and report results to their respective boards of education and to the department of
22 elementary and secondary education.

23 5. Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:

24 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall sunset automatically six
25 years after August 28, 2015, unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly; and

26 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section shall sunset
27 automatically twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and

28 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately following the
29 calendar year in which the program authorized under this section is sunset."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
32 accordingly.
