1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 172,  
2 Page 9, Section 161.855, Line 66, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "167.045. 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, a public school that  
5 participates in an activity sponsored by the Missouri State High School Activities Association  
6 (MSHSAA) shall provide a student that attends a home school, as defined in section 167.031, whose  
7 parent or legal guardian permanently resides in the public school's attendance area with the  
8 opportunity to participate in the activity on behalf of the public school in the same manner that the  
9 public school provides the opportunity to participate to students enrolled in the public school.

10 2. A home school student who seeks to participate or who participates in a MSHSAA  
11 activity on behalf of a public school is subject to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled  
12 in the public school, including policies regarding registration, age eligibility, fees, insurance,  
13 transportation, physical condition, qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of  
14 behavior, and performance.

15 3. As a condition of participation by a home school student in a MSHSAA activity under this  
16 section, the individual who primarily provides instruction to the student shall submit a written  
17 verification to the public school indicating whether the student is:

18 (1) Receiving a passing grade in each course or subject taught; and

19 (2) Maintaining satisfactory progress towards academic advancement or promotion.

20 4. A home school student is not authorized by this section to participate in a MSHSAA  
21 activity during the remainder of any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in  
22 a public school.

23 5. For attendance and enrollment for classification purposes, a home school student shall be  
24 weighted the same as a nonpublic school student.

25 6. The MSHSAA may not prohibit a home school student from participating in activities in  
26 the manner authorized by this section."; and

28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
29 accordingly.
