1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 180, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by
2 deleting the words "penalties for allowing minors to possess intoxicating liquor, with penalty
3 provisions" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "alcohol, with penalty provisions and an
4 emergency clause"; and

6 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said line the
7 following:

8 "311.057. 1. No person, firm, partnership, or corporation licensed under this chapter; public
9 venue; or any person acting as an employee or agent thereof shall sell, offer to sell, or serve free of
10 charge any form of powdered alcohol.

11 2. For the purposes of this section, "powdered alcohol" shall mean alcohol that is prepared in
12 a powdered, crystalline, or capsule form either for direct use or for reconstitution in a nonalcoholic
13 liquid."; and

15 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 311.310, Line 36, by inserting after all of said line
16 the following:

17 "577.180. 1. A person commits the offense of illegal possession of powdered alcohol if he
18 or she purchases, possesses, offers for sale or use, uses, or sells powdered alcohol or ships any
19 package or container that contains powdered alcohol into this state.

20 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a class C
21 misdemeanor.

22 3. For the purposes of this section, "powdered alcohol" shall mean alcohol that is prepared in
23 a powdered, crystalline, or capsule form either for direct use or for reconstitution in a nonalcoholic
24 liquid.

25 4. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the following:

26 (1) Any hospital that operates primarily for the purpose of scientific research;

27 (2) Any state institution conducting scientific research;

28 (3) Any college or university conducting scientific research; or

29 (4) Any pharmaceutical company or biotechnology company conducting research.

30 Section B. Because of the need to protect minors from accidental intoxication and alcohol
31 poisoning, the provisions of sections 311.057 and 577.180 are deemed necessary for the immediate
32 preservation of public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency
33 act within the meaning of the constitution, and sections 311.057 and 577.180 shall be in full force
34 and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

36 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional references accordingly.
