1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 339, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3, by
2 deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "elections."; and

4 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting immediately after said line the
5 following:

7 "66.800. 1. This section shall apply to each election for the county executive, prosecuting
8 attorney, or county assessor in any county with a charter form of government and with more than
9 nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants.

10 2. If no candidate receives at least fifty percent of the votes cast in the general election for
11 such office, the election authority shall, immediately after the results of the election have been
12 announced, issue a proclamation stating that fact and ordering a special election to determine which
13 candidate is elected to the office. The proclamation shall set the date of the election, which shall be
14 not fewer than fourteen or more than thirty days after the proclamation is issued. Only the names of
15 the two candidates who have received the highest percentages of the votes cast in the election for
16 such office shall appear on the special election ballot, and the proclamation shall specify the name of
17 each such candidate. The special election shall be conducted and the votes counted as in other
18 general elections.

19 3. The election authority shall publish legal notice of the special election once at least ten
20 days before the election. The notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the
21 election authority's jurisdiction and shall include the date and time of the election and a sample
22 ballot. The election authority may provide any additional notice of the election it deems desirable.";

25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
