1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 224, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 3 and 4,
2 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the words "to postsecondary education
3 opportunities for high school students, with an emergency clause."; and
4

5 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 160.545, Line 118, by inserting immediately after all of said
6 section and line the following:
7

8 "167.223. 1. Public high schools may, in cooperation with Missouri public [community]
9 two-year colleges and public or private four-year colleges and universities, offer postsecondary
10 course options to high school students. A postsecondary course option allows eligible students to
11 attend vocational or academic classes on a college or university campus and receive both high school
12 and college credit upon successful completion of the course.

13 2. For purposes of state aid, the pupil's resident district shall continue to count the pupil in
14 the average daily attendance of such resident district for any time the student is attending a
15 postsecondary course.

16 3. Any pupil enrolled in a [community] two-year college under a postsecondary course
17 option shall be considered a resident student for the purposes of calculating state aid to the
18 [community] two-year college.

19 4. [Community] Two-year colleges and four-year colleges and universities may charge
20 reasonable fees for pupils enrolled in courses under a postsecondary course option. Such fees may
21 be paid by the district of residence or by the pupil, as determined by the agreement between the
22 district of residence and the college or university."; and

24 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section B, Line 3, by inserting after the word, "semester," the
25 words, "section 160.545 of"; and

27 Further amend said page and section, Line 6, by inserting after the first occurrence of the word,
28 "and" the words, "section 160.545 of"; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
31 accordingly.
