1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 517 & 754, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3,
2 by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the words "relating to taxation."; and

4 Further amend said bill, Pages 4, Section 144.020, Line 63, by inserting immediately after said line
5 the following:

7 "3. (1) In addition to all other taxes imposed under this chapter, a tax is hereby levied and
8 imposed upon all sellers for the privilege of engaging in the business of selling tangible personal
9 property or rendering taxable service at retail in this state. The rate of such additional tax shall be
10 equivalent to one percent of the purchase price of all tangible personal property or taxable services
11 rendered at retail in this state that are taxable under this section.

12 (2) There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Peace Officer Video Camera Sales Tax
13 Fund", which shall consist of money collected under this subsection. The state treasurer shall be
14 custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may
15 approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, money in the
16 fund shall be used solely as provided in this subsection and section 590.715. Notwithstanding the
17 provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the
18 biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest
19 moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned
20 on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

21 590.715. 1. All uniformed law enforcement officers in this state shall wear a video camera
22 affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty. The video camera shall record the
23 interaction between a law enforcement officer and a member of the public. The recording shall
24 include both audio and video.

25 2. All law enforcement agencies shall preserve any recordings made by a video camera
26 under this section for a minimum of thirty days and shall develop any policies and procedures
27 necessary to execute the provisions of this section.

28 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to detectives or other law enforcement
29 officers while they are working in an undercover capacity, or to any law enforcement officer in any
30 situation where the wearing of such a video camera would endanger the safety of the officer or the
31 public."; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
34 accordingly.
