1 AMEND House Bill No. 643, Page 1, In the title, Lines 2-3, by deleting the words, "the Missouri
2 local government employees' retirement system" and insert in lieu thereof the words, "local
3 government retirement systems"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 5, Section 70.631, Line 22, by inserting after all of said line the
6 following:

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8 "86.207. 1. Except as provided herein, all persons who become policemen and all policemen
9 who enter or reenter the service of [the] any city not within a county after the first day of October,
10 1957, become members as a condition of their employment and shall receive no pensions or
11 retirement allowance from any other pension or retirement system supported wholly or in part by the
12 city not within a county or the state of Missouri, nor shall they be required to make contributions
13 under any other pension or retirement system of the city not within a county or the state of Missouri
14 for the same period of service, anything to the contrary notwithstanding. Any employee of a city not
15 within a county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city under
16 section 95.540 and subsequently becomes a policeman may elect to remain a member of said
17 retirement plan and shall not be required to become a member of a police retirement system
18 established under section 86.200. However, an employee of a city not within a county who is
19 earning creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city under section 95.540 and who
20 subsequently becomes a policeman may elect to transfer membership and creditable service to the
21 police retirement system created under section 86.200. Such transfers are subject to the conditions
22 and requirements contained in section 105.691 and are also subject to any existing agreements
23 between the said retirement plans, provided however, transfers completed prior to January 1, 2016
24 shall occur without regard to the vesting requirements of the receiving plan, contained in section
25 105.691. As part of the transfer process described herein, the respective retirement plans may
26 require the employee to acknowledge and agree as a condition of transfer that any election made
27 under this section is irrevocable, constitutes a waiver of any right to receive retirement and disability
28 benefits except as provided by the police retirement system, and that plan terms may be modified in
29 the future.

30 2. If any member ceases to be in service for more than one year unless the member has
31 attained the age of fifty-five or has twenty years or more of creditable service, or if the member
32 withdraws the member's accumulated contributions or if the member receives benefits under the
33 retirement system or dies, the member thereupon ceases to be a member; except in the case of a
34 member who has served in the Armed Forces of the United States and has subsequently been
35 reinstated as a policeman. A member who has terminated employment as a police officer, has
36 actually retired and is receiving retirement benefits under the system shall be considered a retired

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1 member.

2 3. A reserve officer shall not be considered a member of the system for the purpose of
3 determining creditable service, nor shall any contributions be due. A reserve officer shall not be
4 entitled to any benefits from the system other than those awarded when the reserve officer originally
5 retired under section 86.250, nor shall service as a reserve officer prohibit distribution of those
6 benefits."; and

8 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
9 accordingly.
