1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 322,
2 Page 7, Section 208.010, Line 210, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "208.025. 1. The department of social services shall not seek, apply for, accept, or renew
5 any waiver of requirements established under 7 U.S.C. Section 2015(o). The provisions of this
6 subsection shall terminate on January 1, 2019.

7 2. Any ongoing savings resulting from a reduction in state expenditures due to modification
8 of the supplemental nutrition assistance program under this section or the temporary assistance for
9 needy families program effective on August 28, 2015, and subject to appropriations, shall be used to
10 provide child care assistance for single parent households, education assistance, transportation
11 assistance, and job training for individuals receiving benefits under such programs as allowable
12 under applicable state and federal law.

13 208.035. 1. No benefit other than cash assistance shall be considered a benefit granting
14 categorical eligibility for the supplemental nutrition assistance program under 7 U.S.C. Section
15 2014(a).

16 2. The gross income standards of the supplemental nutrition assistance program shall not
17 exceed the standards specified in 7 U.S.C. Section 2014(c).

18 3. The resource limit standards of the supplemental nutrition assistance program shall not
19 exceed the standards specified in 7 U.S.C. Section 2014(g)(1). No benefit other than cash assistance
20 shall be considered a benefit exempting households from such resource limits under 7 U.S.C. Section
21 2014(j)."; and
