2 inserting in lieu thereof the word "source"; and

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4 Further amend said bill, page, section and line, by inserting immediately before the word "sulfur" the
5 words "one-hour"; and

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7 Further amend said bill, page and section, Line 5, by deleting the word "unit" and inserting in lieu
8 thereof the word "source"; and

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10 Further amend said bill, page and section, Line 6, by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu
11 thereof the following:

12 "network shall be adequate to monitor the ambient air quality for sulfur dioxide surrounding
13 the entire electric generating source and"; and

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15 Further amend said bill, page and section, Line 7, by deleting the word "months" and inserting in lieu
16 thereof the word "quarters"; and

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18 Further amend said bill, page and section, Lines 8-10, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in
19 lieu thereof the following:

22 either modeling or monitoring the air quality around such source. The location of any monitoring
23 network installed by such electric generating source within a one-hour sulfur dioxide nonattainment
24 area shall be approved by the department.

7 thereof the number "3"; and
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9 Further amend said bill, page and section, Line 22, by inserting immediately before the word "prior"
10 the words "and under any agreement authorized under subsection 3 of this section"; and
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12 Further amend said bill, page and section, Line 23, by deleting the words "permit"; and
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14 Further amend said bill, page and section, Lines 24-39, by deleting all of said line and inserting in
15 lieu thereof the following

16 "or other requirement for purposes of the one-hour National Ambient Air Quality Standard for any
17 electric generating source that has elected to install a monitoring network under this section, except:

18 (1) The department may propose to the commission any sulfur dioxide limitations or
19 emission reduction requirements specifically agreed to in any voluntary agreement entered into
20 between the department and any owner of an electric generating source that has elected to install a
21 monitoring network under this section; and

22 (2) The department may propose to the commission any adjustments to the sulfur dioxide
23 limitations or emission reduction requirements applicable to any electric generating source located in
24 a non attainment area and subject to an agreement referenced in subsection 3 of this section, as
25 justified by an ambient air quality analysis relying on no fewer than two quarters of monitored data
26 collected through the monitoring network required in subsection 1 of this section and consistent with
27 such agreement.

28 4. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the department from entering into an agreement with
29 an owner of an electric generating source to limit or reduce sulfur dioxide emissions at such affected
30 source that is below the source's permitted sulfur dioxide emission rate."; and
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32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
33 accordingly.
