AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to reimbursement for automobile damage inflicted by deer.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 252.270, to read as follows:

3 **252.270. The department of conservation shall reimburse any automobile owner**
4 **in an amount up to five hundred dollars for damages sustained to the automobile due to**
5 **hitting or being hit by a deer. The department of conservation shall establish rules and**
6 **regulations to implement the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as**
7 **that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this**
8 **section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions**
9 **of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are**
10 **nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly under chapter 536**
11 **to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently**
held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void.
