**Bill Summary:** This proposal specifies that no title insurer, title agency, or person adversely affected by the filing of a fraudulent title document shall be liable to any other party adversely affected.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis
