
- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

§ 275.352 - Beef Commodity Merchandising Fees:

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture** assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Small business beef producers may see an increase in the state portion of the beef checkoff fee as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
