Subject: Law Enforcement Officers and Agencies; Counties

Bill Summary: This proposal allows any sheriff or deputy sheriff to assist another county's law enforcement if requested and specifies that the assisting county is responsible for all expenses and liability.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, the **St. Louis County Police** and the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
