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**Bill Summary:** This proposal designates provisions requiring peace officers' employment records to be available to hiring law enforcement agencies as the "Tyronne L. Thompson Law."

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety (Missouri Highway Patrol, Office of the Director, and Capitol Police)** as well as the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
