Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits the governor from making appointments of state legislators to positions in exchange for votes on legislation and requires gubernatorial appointments to make political contribution disclosures.

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)** assume no fiscal impact. However, should MEC identify significant violations during the process established by §105.955.14 (2), (3), or complaints increase significantly, an investigator would be required to provide the proper oversight.

Oversight assumes that should MEC have a significant increase in complaints, they can seek additional resources through the appropriation process.

Officials at the **Office of the Governor** assume there should be no added cost as a result of this proposal.

Officials at the **Missouri Senate** assume no fiscal impact to their organization from this proposal.
