**Bill Summary:** This proposal specifies that an individual who is occupying private property under the authority of the property owner must be permitted to use deadly force in certain situations.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Corrections, Office of Prosecution Services, Office of the State Courts Administrator,** and the **Office of the State Public Defender** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
