Bill Summary: This proposal repeals obsolete, expired, sunset and terminated statutory sections and portions of sections.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of the Governor**, the **Office of Administration**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, the **Department of Economic Development**, the **Missouri Veterans Commission**, the **Department of Social Services**, and the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes that because this proposal only removes obsolete, expire, sunset and terminated statutory sections, it will not have a fiscal impact on state or local government.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
