Subject: Agriculture and Animals; Crimes and Punishment; Disabilities

Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that any person who causes substantial physical injury or death to a service dog shall be ordered to fully compensate for the injury, loss, or replacement of the service dog.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Public Safety's Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Agriculture** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
