Subject: Physicians; Health Care

Bill Summary: Requires any pain management clinic not associated with a hospital to be owned by a physician who is board certified in pain management.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Transportation**, the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, **Missouri Department of Conservation**, and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Certain small pain management businesses could be impacted by this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
