Subject: Nursing and Boarding Homes; Political Subdivisions

Bill Summary: This proposal changes the laws regarding inspections of certain nursing facilities.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire Safety** and **St. Louis County** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the following **fire protection districts**: Battlefield Fire Protection District, Central County Fire and Rescue, Centralia Fire Department, Creve Couer Fire District, DeSoto Rural Fire Protection District, Eureka Fire Protection, Hawk Point Fire Protection District, Hillsboro Fire Protection District, Jefferson County 911 Dispatch, Lake St. Louis Fire District, Mehlville Fire District, Nixa Fire Protection District, Saline Valley Fire Protection District and the Southern Iron County Fire Protection District did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis (continued)

The proposal may have a minor positive fiscal impact on small business nursing facilities if they are licensed by the State of Missouri and are no longer subject to inspections by other political subdivisions of the state. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
