FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume this proposal would allow a candidate to file with more than one political party for an office. Significant changes to the Missouri Centralized Voter Registration (MCVR) database would need to be made for candidate filing and election night reporting. Approximately 200 hours would be needed to make the programming changes at the estimated cost of \$24,000. The changes to MCVR would also allow for candidates to file with more than one political party in local elections.

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Election Commission**, the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission**, and the **Jackson County Board of Election Commission** each assume no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective organizations.
