**Bill Summary:** This proposal modifies the measurement of damages in civil actions for trespass or expanded use of an easement against a rural electric cooperative.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Economic Developments' Public Service Commission**, the **Office of Public Council** and the **Division of Energy** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
