Bill Summary: This proposal requires that an applicant for a navigator license must take an exam created by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.


Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Office of Prosecution Services**, and the **Department of Corrections** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Small businesses navigators may be impacted by this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
