AN ACT

To amend chapter 211, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to punishment for juveniles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 211, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 211.067, to read as follows:

3 **211.067. Notwithstanding any provision of law, in lieu of being detained or fined**
4 **for a misdemeanor violation, violating an ordinance, or as a condition of probation, the**
5 **juvenile court shall consider ordering the juvenile to attend school. If the juvenile obtains**
6 **two unexcused absences, the juvenile may then be detained or fined, as determined by the**
7 **juvenile court.**
