AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to disclosures by peace officer applicants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 590.015, to read as follows:

590.015. During the application or interview process for employment as a peace officer, a person shall disclose whether he or she has had any complaints, disciplinary actions, or internal investigations as a peace officer while employed with another law enforcement agency. If such person has had any prior complaints, disciplinary actions, or internal investigations, such person shall undergo a psychological evaluation prior to being hired as a peace officer to determine whether he or she can effectively work in the field of law enforcement. If after the psychological evaluation the person is found to be able to effectively work in the field of law enforcement, such person shall receive additional training addressing the issue resulting in such complaint, disciplinary action, or internal investigation.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
