AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the divided highway transportation fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 304.007, to read as follows:

304.007. 1. Any fee or fine collected as a result of a traffic stop or violation on or along the federal interstate system of highways or any other divided highway shall be deposited into the divided highway transportation fund to be disbursed in accordance with subsection 2 of this section.

2. There is hereby created in the state treasury the Divided Highway Transportation Fund", which shall consist of money collected under subsection 1 of this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, shall be disbursed in the following manner:

(1) Forty-five percent shall be disbursed to the department of transportation to be distributed to its districts based on the percentage of lane miles of interstate or divided highway the district has in its jurisdiction;

(2) Twenty percent shall be disbursed to municipalities to be used for transportation purposes based on the percentage of lane miles compared to the total state miles of interstate or divided highway the municipality has within its limits;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

16 **(3) Twenty percent shall be disbursed to counties based on the percentage of lane**
17 **miles compared to the total state miles of interstate or divided highway the county has**
18 **within its limits;**

19 **(4) Ten percent shall be disbursed to the foundation formula; and**

20 **(5) Five percent shall be disbursed to the state highway patrol.**

21 **3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080, to the contrary, any moneys**
22 **remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the**
23 **general revenue fund.**

24 **4. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other**
25 **funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited**
26 **to the fund.**
