AN ACT

To amend chapter 192, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the inspection of certain x-ray systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 192, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 192.500, to read as follows:

- 192.500. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall mean:
- 2 (1) "Cone beam computed tomography system", a medical imaging device using x-3 ray computed tomography to capture data using a cone-shaped x-ray beam;
 - (2) "Panoramic x-ray system", an imaging device that captures the entire mouth in a single, two-dimensional image including the teeth, upper and lower jaws, and surrounding structures and tissues.
 - 2. Cone beam computed tomography systems and panoramic x-ray systems shall not be required to be inspected more frequently than every six years.
 - 3. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:
- 10 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall automatically sunset on December thirty-first two years after August 28, 2015, unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly;
- 13 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section 14 shall automatically sunset on December thirty-first twelve years after the effective date of 15 the reauthorization of this section; and

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
