AN ACT

To repeal section 262.590, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the duties of a University of Missouri extension council.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 262.590, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 262.590, to read as follows:

262.590. The council in any county shall have the right and duty to:

(1) Make recommendations and suggestions to the university concerning the extension program;

(2) Make recommendations and suggestions to the university concerning the appointment or removal of extension personnel;

(3) Arrange for and administer the county's share of the cost of the extension services in the area over which the council has jurisdiction;

(4) Receive by way of gift, purchase, or otherwise acquire, in its own name, real or personal property with the right to hold and to sell and convey title to any such property **and to**

obtain financing, in its own name, in connection with such purchase or acquisition; provided no real estate not reasonably required for the administration of the extension program shall be held by the council for a period longer than two years; **and provided further that the financed amount shall not constitute a debt of the university, and the university shall have no obligation for repayment for any part of such financed amount.**
