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### AN ACT

To amend chapter 334, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to pain management clinics.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 334, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 334.290, to read as follows:

334.290. 1. For purposes of this section, the term “pain management clinic” shall  
2 mean a privately owned clinic, facility, or office in which any health care provider licensed  
3 under this chapter provides chronic nonmalignant pain treatment to a majority of its  
4 patients for ninety days or more in a twelve-month period or a privately owned clinic,  
5 facility, or office which advertises in any medium for pain management services of any  
6 type. For purposes of determining if a clinic, facility, or office qualifies as a pain  
7 management clinic under this section, the entire clinic, facility, or office caseload of  
8 patients who received health care services from all medical doctors, osteopathic physicians,  
9 advanced practice registered nurses, and physician assistants who serve in the clinic,  
10 facility, or office shall be counted.

11 2. Any pain management clinic not affiliated with a hospital shall be owned by a  
12 physician who is licensed in this state and board certified in pain management.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
