### AN ACT

To amend chapter 8, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the operation of a farmers' market at the state capitol.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 8, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 8.195, to read as follows:

**8.195. 1. For purposes of this section, the term “farmers’ market” shall have the same meaning as defined in section 144.527.**

**2. During the months of March to November, the operation of a farmers’ market shall be allowed on the grounds of the state capitol.**

**3. The office of administration shall promulgate rules and regulations regarding the operation of any farmers’ market operated on the grounds of the state capitol under this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void.**
