AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to government websites established by political subdivisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 67.2730, to read as follows:

67.2730. 1. Every county and municipality shall establish and operate its own government website available to members of the public.

2. Every county and municipality shall update its government website established under this section each month.

3. Every county and municipality shall include all of the following items on its government website established under this section:

(1) Its most recent financial report;

(2) All its ordinances, codes, and regulations currently in effect;

(3) Its most recently adopted budget;

(4) An archive that provides access to its agenda and meeting minutes;

(5) Information on its elected officials and governmental staff, including the date of the end of the term for each elected official and the name, title, and contact information for each elected official and governmental staff member;

(6) The name, title, and official contact information for its custodian of records;

(7) Hours of operation for its offices;

(8) If operating a court, the hours of operation for the court and the names of the judge, city attorney, and prosecutor;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

- 18 **(9) The time and location of its next board or council meeting;**
- 19 **(10) The contact information for the police and fire departments.**
