1 **WHEREAS**, the profession of lineworker is steeped in personal, family, and professional
2 tradition; and

4 **WHEREAS**, lineworkers are often first responders during storms and other catastrophic
5 events, working to make the scene safe for other public safety heroes; and

7 **WHEREAS**, lineworkers work with thousands of volts of electricity high atop power
8 lines twenty-four hours a day, 365 days a year, to keep electricity flowing; and

10 **WHEREAS**, lineworkers often work under dangerous conditions far from their families
11 to construct and maintain the energy infrastructure of this state; and

13 **WHEREAS**, lineworkers put their lives on the line every day with little recognition from
14 the community regarding the danger of their work; and

16 **WHEREAS**, April 13, 2015, would be an appropriate date to designate as Missouri
17 Lineworker Appreciation Day:

19 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House
20 of Representatives, Ninety-eighth General Assembly, recognize April 13, 2015, as "Missouri
21 Lineworker Appreciation Day" in support of the contributions of the brave men and women who
22 keep the power on and protecting public safety; and

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Missouri House of Representatives encourages
25 the citizens of this state to devote some portion of Missouri lineworker appreciation day to
26 recognition and contemplation of the sacrifices undertaken by lineworkers in performance of
27 their duties and to observe the day with appropriate events and activities.
