

HB 329 -- ANIMAL TRESPASS

SPONSOR: Reiboldt

Currently, a person is guilty of animal trespass if a person with ownership or custody of an animal fails to provide adequate control of the animal for a period of 12 hours or more. This bill changes the crime to livestock trespass. The bill defines "livestock" as cattle, swine, sheep, ratite birds, specified aquatic products, llamas, alpaca, buffalo, specified elk not from the wild and raised in confinement, goats and poultry, equine and exotic animals.
